Last week, on a visit at Wal-Mart, a man, who we assumed was an employee, stopped my husband, and asked him if he needed help. He then asked if he was "from here" because there are so many "illegal aliens" running around Napa. My initial reaction was that my husband is not from "outer space". Then I proceeded to become enraged and reported this to an employee in the front of the store who seemed to brush it off as an insignificant incident. The current political climate in our society is disturbing. Consider last week's murder of the "Indian" engineer and the racist who thought the man was Middle Eastern.
